Possible Items for ChemoCare Bags

(items are to be provided by the volunteer group)

- Travel-sized tissue bags
- Hand sanitizer (small bottles)
- Lotions
- Activity booklets—crossword puzzles, word finds, etc.
- Pens
- Lip balm (unscented)
- Teams can also write notes of encouragement to include in the bags.
- Cancer CAREpoint will provide the bag.

A team of approximately 20 individuals can assemble approximately 100 bags in two hours.

A separate team-building activity makes No-Sew blankets, which will also be included in the ChemoCare bags. If your team chooses to assemble the bags only, Cancer CAREpoint can provide blankets for the bags.
